## Description:

Immerse yourself into the local life and nomadic culture on this easy to moderate 4-day horse trek. With an expert wrangler leading the way, ride along a winding mountainous trail through inspiring red rock hills, green valleys, and canyons inhabited by shepherd families.

Days	Activities
	Arslanbob to Kyzyl Unkur gorge, 7-8 hours
Day 1	Breakfast. Meet crew, a horseman will demonstrate the Asian horse-riding techniques. We ride out
	Arslanbob village, passing traditional houses built out of clay, each with its own blooming garden full of
	apples, apricot, and walnut. The hourses are surrounded by fences fashioned from dry tree branches. We
	leave behind the Arslanbob village and ride through the walnut forest towards Kyzyl Unkur village. Four
	hours' riding will bring us to the Kyzyl Unkur village. Stop for lunch on riverbank. After lunch, continue
	riding further to overnight spot. We ride through the Otuzart gorge, unique with its incredibly beautiful
	red rock formations. We cross the river several times to arrive at the first camp. Dinner and overnight in a
	tent.

Day 2	Kyzyl Unkur – Otuz Art summer pasture
Day 2	This morning's trek follows the path of the Otuzart river. We cross the river and continue through the
	juniper and apple forest on steep trail. In the valley, we are likely to encounter cows and sheep,
	accompanied by shepherds on horseback. Continue riding in an impressive wild landscape with unusual
	rock formations. After lunch, ride to the campsite. Overnight in a tent.

	Riding Distance: 21 km
	Max Elevation: 2314 m
	Min Elevation: 1440 m
	Total Gain/Loss: +1465 m / - 590
	Campsite: N41° 27.729' E73° 19.516'
Day 3	Otuz Art summer pasture to Kapka Tash lake over Belmonchok pass
	Today we will begin our ascent of Belmonchok Pass(3,185m). Follow the trail in a very narrow rocky gorge
	used by local shepherds to move their livestock up to alpine meadows. At some point, we get off our
	horse and walk the trail for our safety. Here on the top of the pass the mountain air is sweet, and the
	views are amazing. We continue our riding downhill along the gushing stream to our campsite at the bank
	of the alpine lake Kapka-Tash. We enjoy wonderful views of the lake with picturesque landscapes, flocks

	of sheep and cattle grazing on the shore. Overnight: Tented camp
	Riding Time: 5-6 hours
	Riding Distance: 12 km
	Max Elevation: 3185 m
	Min Elevation: 2304 m
	Total Gain/Loss: +933 m / - 939
	Campsite: N41° 31.040' E73° 20.813'
Day 4	Kapka Tash lake to Kara Suu lake
	Today we mostly ride along these turquoise alpine lakes of Alatai National Park. After short riding we
	leave behind the Kapka Tash lake and the trail then drops steeply down along the gushing river, passing a
	couple of shepherd's camps, we then reach the Kara-Suu lake. The Kara –Suu Lake is 6.5 km long, around
	3 hours of riding from one end to another. During the ride we enjoy wonderful views of the lake
	beautified with juniper and spruce trees, flocks of sheep and cows grazing on the slopes. Lunch on the
	shore of the lake. After lunch, continue riding towards pick up point. Farewell with the crew. Transfer to
	Toktogul village. Night in a homstay.
